## Outreach to Ghana, near and far

### Meetings with community churches emphasizes ministry to children and discipleship

#### Trip to Upper East and Northern Region

In the month of March, the Nissan 4X4 Double Cabin Pickup crossed the 200,000 kilometer line. Almost 3,000 new kilometers were put on the odometer when the team traveled to the Upper East and Northern Regions of Ghana. In line with the vision to reach the unreached, a missionary trip was undertaken from the 7th – 14th March. The trip covered towns and communities in Zebilla, Wulugu, Kulenga, Sargadugu, Langbesi, Samini, Tangbini, etc.

The Mamprugu and Kusaal lands were visited whilst Discipleship training and Children's Ministry were emphasized in the meetings with the leadership of the Community Churches (our partners). It was also very important to meet missionaries, disciples and some members of the general leadership of the Community Church.

We visited some of the local branches and shared fellowship and the word of God with them. In Zebilla, we spoke with Pastor Kojo Issaka whose disciples are leading their membership to explore chapel building through self-help. The unfinished clay-mould chapel was shown to us but we were cautioned that if nothing was done to roof it soon, it would fall back into the dirt by the onset of the heavy and torrential rains expected for the main season of the year.

**March Outreaches – Operation Launch Out**

The month of March was set aside for the launch of effective soulwinning strategies in various local branch Churches. In the Tema – Ashaiman District, various churches carried out outreaches and crowned it all with a District Joint prayer vigil and a Joint Service on the 26th March 2017. The Graceland Assembly in Golf City, under Tema Municipality, hosted the gathering and was supported in their bid to acquire a piece of land for development.



**Business Development Seminar (Part One)**

As part of the 20th Anniversary celebration, three Business Development Seminars have been planned and the first was executed. The keynote speaker, Lawyer Willie Adjetey-Solomon made a clear and succinct point to the effect that until we discover the causes of poverty, we stand to be consumed by the consequences of poverty. He clearly outlined some steps to overcoming poverty and setting up effective businesses which would change the lot of Christians, especially young people. **LBM Mission Farms Ltd**

The Ve Community is a farming one located near Hohoe in the Volta Region of Ghana. The LBM farm in Ve - Koelenu depends on the vagaries of the weather needing a well or borehole to facilitate perennial productivity. This farm when fully operational will serve as a model and source of skill development transfer and livelihood empowerment tool for the community. Currently, food crops such as maize and cassava are cultivated.

The members of this project are in dire need of basic inputs, but could not afford them due to economic hardships. The major problem faced by the project and which it will try to address is the inappropriate rain pattern which prevents increased productivity to achieve efficiency in their farming activities. Agriculture contributes more than 60% of Ghana's economic viability but the Ve – Koelenu community depends on agriculture for more than 80% of its livelihood. The LBM Mission Farms Ltd aims at overcoming the lack of water for productivity by providing a borehole facility.

The mission of LBM in planting vibrant and healthy churches as well as engaging in developmental projects to better the lot and living standards of those they minister the Gospel to by way of doing holistic ministry necessitated the start of a farm project in this community around 2011 to address the socio-economic needs of the people.
